COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 916, L.D. 1130, Bill, "AN ACT to Improve Procedures under the State Employees Labor Relations Act."

Amend said Bill in section 5 by striking out all of the 2nd (stricken out) sentence of that part designated subsection 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The appropriation for the board and the executive director shall be included in the budget of the ~~Bureau of Labor and Industry~~ Department of Manpower Affairs and authorization for expenditures shall be the responsibility of the executive director.'

Statement of Fact

Under current legislation, the budget for the Public Employees Labor Relations Board and its executive director is approved by the Director of the Bureau of Labor and Industry before going to the Department of Manpower Affairs and through the conventional budget process of the Executive Branch. Legislative Document 1130 provides that this budget shall go directly to the Legislature, skipping all Executive Branch review. The purpose of this amendment is to omit only approval by the Director of Labor and Industry, but continue all other current Executive Branch review.
