STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Provide Retirement Credit to Forester's Spouse under the Maine State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

5 MRSA § 1094, sub-§ 15 is enacted to read:

15. Uncompensated time worked credit. The spouse of any forester may claim creditable service for the time she performed forest service work and for which she was not compensated. This subsection shall apply only to services performed prior to June 2, 1972.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to give recognition to these state employees for the services they performed and to allow them retirement credits for this service.
