STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Concerning Per Diem Payments to Trustees of the State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 5 MRSA § 1031, sub-§ 2, as last amended by PL 1971, c. 17, § 3, is further amended to read:
- 2. Expenses. The trustees shall be reimbursed from the funds of the retirement system for all necessary expenses that they may incur through service on the board of trustees and shall be entitled to a payment of \$35 per diem in addition to expenses when engaged in the performance of authorized retirement system duties, except those members appointed by the Governor and Council shall receive a payment of \$100 per diem in addition to expenses.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would increase payment of public members of the Retirement Board from \$35 per diem and expenses to \$100 per diem and expenses.
