COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 345, L.D. 1146, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide the Citizens of the State of Maine with Uniform
Quality Pharmaceutical Health Care."

Amend said Bill in subsection 1 of that part designated
"§2911." by striking out in the 4th line (3rd line of L.D.) the
underlined word "must" and inserting in place thereof the underlined
word 'may'

Further amend said Bill in subsection 1 of that part designated
"§2911." by striking out in the 9th line the first underlined word
"shall" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'may'
(7th line of L.D.)

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2913." by
striking out in the 3rd line the underlined figure "1975" and
inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '1977'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end before the
Statement of Fact the following:

'§2915. Limitation

Any data or information contained in the patient profile record
system shall be held in confidence and shall not be disclosed to
any person without the consent of the particular patient whose record
is involved.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment permits, rather than requires, the pharmacist
to provide information relating to the use of the drug purchased.
In addition, the continuing education requirement is made effective
in 1977 rather than 1975 and information contained in the patient
profile system is made confidential.
