COMMITTEE AMENDMENT"B" to S.P. 345, L.D. 1146, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide the Citizens of the State of Maine with Uniform Quality Pharmaceutical Health Care."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the first sentence of subsection 1 of that part designated "§2911." the underlined word "must" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'may'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 2nd sentence of subsection 1 of that part designated "§2911." the underlined word "shall" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'may'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the first sentence of that part designated "<u>\$2912.</u>" the underlined word "<u>shall</u>" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'may'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "§2913"

Further amend said Bill by renumbering that part designated "\$2914." to be '\$2913.'

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for the optional communication of certain patient information and the optional maintenance of a patient profile system.
