STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Prevent Unauthorized Hunting on Private Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2469 is enacted to read:

§ 2469. Hunting on land of another

No person shall hunt upon the land of another without the permission of the landowner. Any person hunting upon the land of another shall stop and identify himself upon the request of the landowner or his duly authorized representative. Any person in violation of this section shall be held accountable to the owner under existing law.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will permit hunting on the land of another in the same manner that snowmobiling on the land of another is now permitted.
