STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Provide a Cost-of-Living Increase to Supplemental Security Income Recipients.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare the sum of \$726,570 for the biennium to be used for the provision of a percentage increase in accordance with the United States Consumer Price Index pursuant to Title 22, section 3273, subsection 6, paragraph B for the state supplemental income benefit only and for that benefit included in Title 22, section 3273, subsection 1, paragraph A, only.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Public Law 1973, chapter 790, provided for an automatic cost-of-living increase to supplemental security income recipients on July 1st of each year. This Act would provide the allocation necessary to provide an anticipated 12.5% cost-of-living increase to the state optional supplement. Federal Public Law 93-368 provides for a cost-of-living increase for federal SSI benefits.
