COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P.344, L.D.1160,  
Bill, "AN ACT Creating the Post-secondary  
Education Commission of Maine."

Amend said Bill in section 3 in that part  
designated "§76." by striking out in the 3rd line  
(2nd line of L.D.) the underlined figure "15"  
and inserting in place thereof the underlined  
figure '16'

Further amend said Bill in section 3 in that  
part designated "§76." by inserting after  
paragraph D of subsection 1 the following:

'E. One position to be shared on the  
basis of 2-year terms between a member of  
the Board of Trustees of the Maine Maritime  
Academy and an appointment representing the  
general public who shall be selected in  
accordance with subsection 5. The original  
2-year appointment shall be filled by the  
trustee of the Maine Maritime Academy.'

Further amend said Bill in section 3 in that  
part designated "§80." by striking out all of the  
last paragraph.

Statement of Fact

This amendment accomplishes the following  
goals:

1. It changes the number of members of PECOM  
from 15 to 16.
2. The 16th member is alternately a Trustee  
of the Maine Maritime Academy and of the general  
public.
3. It strikes out a provision applying  
penalties to institutions which refuse to give  
information to the commission.
