SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 344, L.D. 1160, Bill, "AN ACT  
Creating the Post-secondary Education Commission of Maine."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 23 and  
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 23. Appropriation. There is appropriated to  
the Post-secondary Education Commission from the General  
Fund for the purpose of operation for the fiscal year  
beginning July 1, 1975 and ending June 30, 1976, the sum of  
\$50,000. The breakdown shall be as follows:
