AN ACT to Grant Liquor Enforcement Inspectors the Same Powers  
of Arrest as Sheriffs.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

28 MRSA § 55, sub-§ 14, 4th sentence is amended to read:

They shall have the same powers and duties throughout the several counties of the State as sheriffs have in their respective counties ~~relating to liquor~~.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill will grant full powers of arrest to liquor enforcement inspectors so that they might augment local police agencies throughout the State in matters of related offenses with which they are constantly in contact.
