AN ACT Relating to the Definition of Public Place in the Statute Prohibiting Drinking of Alcoholic Beverages in Public Places not Licensed for the Sale of Liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

17 MRSA § 2003, sub-§ 2, is amended to read:

2. **Public place defined.** "Public place" as used in this section shall mean any common carrier, dance, entertainment, **location where admission is charged**, amusement or sport or grounds adjacent thereto and used in conjunction therewith or any highway, street or lane, to which the public is invited or has access.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act expands the definition of "public place" under the statute prohibiting drinking of liquor in unlicensed public places to include a location where admission is charged.
