STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Providing a Minimum Service Retirement Allowance under the State Retirement Law for Leonard Sprague of Machias.

Leonard Sprague of Machias: retirement allowance. Resolved: That notwithstanding any other provisions of law, Leonard Sprague of Machias shall receive the minimum retirement allowance for 10 years' service as provided under the State Retirement Law.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Present law permits \$100 per month to any person who has 10 years of creditable service but also requires that any part of this time must be membership service rendered after July 1, 1942. Mr. Sprague was employed in the Highway Department from 1918 until 1932 and separated before the law took effect and as he is now over age 75 cannot become reemployed and cannot qualify for this benefit by becoming a contributing member.
