SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1174, L.D.1172,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Veteran's Property  
Tax Exemption."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section  
3 the following:

'Sec. 4. 36 MRSA §653, sub-§1, ¶H, is  
repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

H. Any municipality granting exemptions under  
this subsection shall have a valid claim  
against the State to recover 30% of the taxes  
lost by reason of such exemptions, upon proof  
of the facts in form satisfactory to the  
Commissioner of Finance and Administration.  
Such claims shall be presented to the  
Legislature next convening.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering  
section 4 to be section 5.

Fiscal Note


The estimated cost of reimbursing municipalities  
for property taxes lost under this exemption would  
be approximately .9 million dollars in the fiscal  
year ending in 1977.

Statement of Fact
