AN ACT to Increase Certain Hunting and Fishing License Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA § 2401, sub-§ 3, 4th ¶, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 276, is further amended to read:

The following schedule of fees is established:

| B. Resident hunting 16 years of age or older | \$6.50 \$8.00 |
| C. Junior nonresident hunting 10-16 years of age Permits hunting of all species except deer and bear. Application shall be accompanied by the written consent of his or her parent or guardian. | \$12.50 \$17.50 |
| D. Resident combination hunting and fishing | \$10.50 \$13.00 |
| E. Nonresident small game hunting Permits hunting of all species except bear and deer. | \$22.50 \$35.50 |
| F. Nonresident big game hunting Permits hunting for all species including bear and deer. | \$46.50 \$65.50 |

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA § 2401-B, sub-§ 3, ¶¶ A to F, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 409, § 2, are amended to read:

| A. Junior nonresident fishing 12-16 years of age. | \$2.50 \$3.50 |
| B. Resident fishing 16 years of age or older. | \$6.50 \$8.00 |
| C. Resident or nonresident 3-day fishing Any resident of the State who procures a 3-day license may exchange the same for an annual resident fishing license in the town in which he resides upon the payment of 50¢ to the clerk or issuing agent. | \$6.50 \$9.50 |
| D. Nonresident 7-day fishing Valid for 7 days from date as indicated on license. | \$7.50 \$11.50 |
| E. Nonresident 15-day fishing Valid for 15 days from date as indicated on license. | \$10.50 \$15.50 |
| F. Nonresident season fishing 16 years of age or older. | \$15.50 \$21.50 |

Sec. 3. 12 MRSA § 2502, 1st sentence, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 208, § 4, is further amended to read:

An archery license shall be issued by the commissioner to hunt deer from the first Monday of October to the beginning of the regular deer hunting season as described in section 2353, the fee for which shall be ~~\$6.50~~ \$8 for hunting deer by residents of this State and ~~\$42.50~~ \$65.50 for hunting deer by non-residents; the fee of 50¢ to be retained by the issuing agent; except that such archery licenses shall also permit the hunting of such wild birds and animals which can be legally hunted from the first Monday of October to the beginning of the regular deer hunting season as described in section 2353.

Sec. 4. Effective date. This Act shall become effective January 1, 1976.
