COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "# " to H.P. 931, L.D. 1175, Bill, "AN ACT to Create a Full-time Board of Environmental Protection."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following: 'AN ACT to Change Provisions of the Law Relating to the Board of Environmental Protection.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §361, 1st 2 ¶¶, as last amended by PL 1971, c. 618, §9, are further amended to read:

The Board of Environmental Protection, as heretofore established and hereinafter in this subchapter called the "board," shall consist of 10 members appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council, 2-of-whom-shall represent-manufacturing-interests-of-the-State,-2-of-whomshall-be-representatives-of-municipalities,-2-of-whom-shall represent-the-public-generally,-2-of-whom-shall-represent the-conservation-interests-in-the-State-and-2-other-members knowledgeable-in-matters-relating-to-air-pollution, and the Commissioner of Environmental Protection ex officio. The members shall be appointed for a term of 3 years and until their successors are appointed and duly qualified. COMMITTEE AMENDMENT to H.P. 931, L.D. 1175 -2-

The members appointed by the Governor shall receive \$25 \$40 per day for their services at meetings or hearings and all members shall receive necessary traveling expenses for attending any meetings of the board or for any other travel in connection with the official business of the board and under the specific authority of the board, which traveling expenses shall be paid out of the General Fund.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environmental Protection the sum of \$15,750 for the biennium for the purposes of carrying out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
