COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 936, L.D. 1178, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Clarify the Mandatory Provisions of the Workmen's  
Compensation Act with Respect to Farm Laborers."

Amend said Bill in the 8th line (7th line in L.D.) by  
inserting after the underlined words "employer of" the  
following: '4 or less'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to restrict the exception  
to farms employing 4 or less farm laborers. It is expected  
that the subject of farm labor coverage will be taken up in  
a planned general study of workmen's compensation later this  
year.
