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AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officers of Kennebec County.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 2, 7th ¶, that part relating to Kennebec County, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 724, § 3, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Kennebec County: County commissioners, \$3,561; chairman, \$3,896; clerk of courts, \$8,570.10 in 1975, \$9,427.11 in 1976 and thereafter; county treasurer, \$5,565; sheriff, \$9,182.80 in 1975, \$10,101.08 in 1976 and thereafter; register of deeds \$8,570.10 in 1975, \$9,427.11 in 1976 and thereafter; judge of probate, \$9,180.60 in 1975, \$10,098.66 in 1976 and thereafter; register of probate, \$8,570.10 in 1975, \$9,427.11 in 1976 and thereafter;

The purpose of this bill is to allow salary increases for certain elected officials in Kennebec County.
