COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 953, L.D. 1192, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Candidates for Public Office who are Running as Independents."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 4th line (3rd line in L.D.) the underlined words "one year" and inserting in place thereof the figure and word '3 months'

Statement of Fact

The bill restricts a person from running for office as an independent, by nomination petition, if he has been enrolled in a party within one year before the filing date. The amendment changes that time limit to 3 months.
