SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 954, L.D. 1193, RESOLVE, Authorizing the Bureau of Public Lands to Convey the State's Interest in a Lot in Trescott, Washington County, to Clarify Title.

Amend said Resolve in the Title by inserting at the end before the period the following: 'and in a Lot in Richmond, Sagadahoc County, to Clarify Title'

Amend said Resolve by striking out at the end, before the Statement of Fact, the period and inserting in place thereof the following:

'; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the Director of the Bureau of Public Lands, Department of Conservation, is authorized to lease, sell or otherwise convey the interest of the State in a certain parcel of land located in the Town of Richmond, County of Sagadahoc and described as follows: Approximately one acre of land located on the west side of the River Road, Route 24, about 5 miles south of Gardiner and about 2/10 of a mile south of Department of Transportation Station 5079 with a building located thereon County all more particularly described in Sagadahoc/registry of deeds, book 402, page 96, upon such terms and conditions and for such considerations as he deems reasonable.'

Statement of Fact

The State acquired an interest in the property which is the subject of the amendment through operation of the escheat laws. The state's interest has never been recorded and Mr. Earle Farley of Richmond purchased the land from the Town of Richmond which had imposed tax liens on property it thought D OF & SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 954, L.D. 1193, -2-

abandoned. Mr. Farley now seeks to clear his title by acquiring the state's interest in the property.
