CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 371,
L.D. 1198, Bill, "AN ACT Providing for the Observance of
Memorial Day on May 30th."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end before the
Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 5. Effective date. This Act shall take effect
whenever the United States Government designates May 30th as
the date for observance of Memorial Day. '

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that the State designation of
May 30th as Memorial Day shall coincide with the designation
of May 30th as Memorial Day by the United States Government.
