AN ACT Relating to Reclassification and Range Changes of Certain Positions and Classifications in State Classified Service.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Reclassification and range changes. The State Personnel Board is directed pursuant to the private and special laws of 1973, chapter 221, section 3, to effect the following reclassifications and range changes, to be effective with the first payroll period following the dates originally approved by that board:
