STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Norman Call of Levant for Loss of Cattle Destroyed by Bear.

Norman Call; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$1,500 to be paid to Norman Call of Levant, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for loss of cattle destroyed by bear.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this resolve to reimburse Norman Call of Levant for loss of 4 of his cattle which were destroyed by bear.
