HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to H.P. 1223, L.D. 1211,
Bill, "AN ACT to Change Weights and Related Pro-
visions for Commercial Vehicles."

Amend said bill in section 4 by inserting
after the 2nd sentence of paragraph A of subsection
1 of that part designated "§1652." the following:
'Vehicles may be operated, or caused to be operated,
on or over any way or bridge with a maximum gross
weight permitted by this section or by section 1655
provided such gross weights do not exceed the fol-
lowing formula:

$$W == 500 \left(\frac{LN}{N-1} + 12N + 36 \right)$$

W == gross weight L == overall distance between
extreme axles

N == number of axles'

Further amend said Bill in section 6 in that
part designated "§1655." in the 15th line (16th
line in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined
figure and punctuation "1652," the following:
'except that in no case shall it exceed the maximum
gross weight permitted by such vehicle under the
formula contained in section 1652, subsection 1,
paragraph A, the 3rd sentence,'
