COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 966, L.D. 1218, Bill,
"AN ACT to Incorporate the Town of Rockwood."

Amend said Bill in section 2 in the last line (same in L.D.) by striking out the words "these dates" and inserting in place thereof the words 'the date of incorporation'

Further amend said Bill in section 4 in the 2nd paragraph by striking out in the 4th and 5th lines (4th line in L.D.) the figure and words "40% of the total number of qualified voters" and inserting in place thereof the figure and words '50% of the qualified voters, voting at the last gubernatorial election'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Fiscal Note

This legislation, if enacted, would result in an estimated net annual loss to the General Fund of \$117,500 on the basis of 3 factors. First, a real property tax loss of \$137,000. Second, a personal property tax loss of \$2,700. Third, a savings in reimbursement to Somerset County in the amount of \$22,200. A factor not considered in the estimate would be the annual net income from the tax assessed for the Maine Forestry District. The breakdown would be as follows:
