SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 966, L.D. 1218, Bill,
"AN ACT to Incorporate the Town of Rockwood."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first and
last sentences of section 1 and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'The unorganized territory located in Somerset County and
consisting of that part and parcels of land within the northern
portions of Townships 1 and 2, Range 1, N.B.K.P., bounded and
described as Rockwood Strip, with the inhabitants therein, is
incorporated into a town by the name of Rockwood.

The town created shall take the effects belonging to that part
and parcels of land within the northern portions of Townships
1 and 2, Range 1, N.B.K.P., bounded and described as Rockwood
Strip located in Somerset County and which have not heretofore
been legally disposed of by the State or by the County of
Somerset.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to restrict the area
to be incorporated as the Town of Rockwood to that area known
as Rockwood Strip.
