AN ACT to Authorize Community and Rural Development Districts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 4524 is enacted to read:

§ 4524. Community and rural development districts

1. Duties. Any community or rural development district authorized under federal legislation shall be organized and have those powers and duties provided under this subchapter.

2. Limitations. No community or rural development district shall be formed where a regional planning commission has been legally constituted.

3. Application. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit a regional planning commission from being eligible to apply for assistance under the community or rural development programs.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will authorize community or rural development districts authorized under federal legislation to have the same powers as regional planning and development districts.
