SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 977, L.D. 1224, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit the Disposal of Moose Killed in Motor Vehicle Accidents."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the Statement of Fact the following underlined sentence:

'No person entitled to the ownership of a deer or moose carcass under this section shall take possession or remove any portion of that carcass unless he takes possession and removes the entire carcass from the scene of the collision.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that any person taking possession of a moose or deer carcass under section 2951 of Title 12 must take possession of the entire carcass and remove it from the scene of the collision.
