RESOLVE, to Refund Clyde Wardwell of Mexico a Portion of Liquor License Fee Due to Loss of Business by Fire.

Clyde Wardwell of Mexico; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$480 to be paid to Clyde Wardwell of Mexico for refund of a portion of liquor license fee due to loss of business by fire.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Mr. Wardwell's place of business was entirely destroyed by fire in January of this year. His license still had 8 months to run at the time of the fire. The purpose of this resolve is to reimburse Clyde Wardwell of Mexico for unused portion of liquor license.
