RESOLVE, Proposing a Study of Methods of Encouraging the Growth and Modernization of the Fisheries Industry in Maine.

Methods of encouraging the growth and modernization of the fisheries industry in Maine. Resolved: That in recognition of the importance of the fisheries industry to Maine and to her people, the Advisory Council to the Department of Marine Resources is directed to study and determine the present condition of the Maine fisheries industry and to further study and determine any and all means available to the State which may be used to achieve expansion and modernization of this industry. For the purposes of conducting this study, the Advisory Council shall conduct public hearings throughout the State in order to solicit and consider testimony for its study. The Advisory Council shall submit the results of its study, together with final drafts of any proposed legislation which, in the judgment of the Advisory Council, will encourage the growth and modernization of the fisheries industry, to the Governor and the Legislature by July 1, 1976.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve directs the Advisory Council to the Department of Marine Resources to conduct a study to determine any means available to the State to encourage the growth and modernization of the fisheries industry in Maine.
