SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 981, L.D. 1244, Bill, "AN ACT to Restrict Liquor Control Commission Records of Liquor Violations to Violations which are Less than 5 Years Old."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof:

'§404. Records

1. Limitation on maintenance of/ records. The commission shall maintain a record of each violation, revocation or suspension for not more than 5 years.

2. Records of felony convictions. Subsection 1 shall not apply to records of felony convictions. Records of felony convictions shall be maintained for at least 5 years and may be maintained for a longer period in accordance with the policy of the commission.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that the commission may maintain records of felony convictions for a period longer than 5 years.
