COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 982, L.D. 1245, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Expenses for Examination of Insurers."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'24-A MRSA §228, sub-§3, ¶C, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 585, §12, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

C. If the admitted assets of the insurer exceed \$25,000,000 an annual payment of an examination expense allotment of 1/5 of an amount equal to .001 of the first \$10,000,000 of the insurer's admitted assets, plus .0002 of the next \$15,000,000 of such assets, plus .000175 of the remainder of such assets as are shown by the insurer's financial statement filed with the superintendent for the preceding calendar year. Such payment shall be made on March 1st with the filing of the insurer's annual statement with the superintendent.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will cause an insurer, under this section, to make annual payments toward its examination expense, giving the Bureau of Insurance a more equal flow of income for examination purposes.
