RESOLVE, Proposing a Study to Investigate the Feasibility of Developing Foreign Trade Zones in this State.

Feasibility of developing foreign trade zones in this State. Resolved: That in recognition of the importance to this State of foreign trade and imports, especially the importation of fuel oil, the Department of Commerce and Industry is directed to study and determine the feasibility and benefits of establishing foreign trade zones in Maine. If it is the conclusion of the study that such a program would be beneficial, final drafts of legislation and administrative action plans shall be prepared. The report of this study, together with final drafts of proposed legislation and administrative action plans, if any, shall be submitted to the Governor and Legislature by July 1, 1976.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve proposes a study of the feasibility of attracting industry to build facilities and create jobs under the concept of foreign trade zones.
