HOUSE AMENDMENT " B" to H.P. 987, L.D. 1252, Bill,
"AN ACT to Permit Uniform Reduction of Liquor Prices in Four
Stores in the State."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the word
"Four" and inserting in place thereof the word 'Five'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after
the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section, the
commission, with the approval of the Commissioner of Finance
and Administration, may reduce the price of liquor in 5 stores
and establish at those 5 stores the price to which the 10%
discount in section 204 shall be applicable. Retail prices
shall be the same in all 5 stores and the prices to which
the 10% discount in section 204 shall be applicable shall be
the same in all 5 stores. One of these 5 stores shall be
located in each of the following municipalities: Machias,
Kittery, Presque Isle, Waterville and Madawaska.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to add a store in
Madawaska to the provisions of the bill.
