**AN ACT to Permit Uniform Reduction of Liquor Prices in Four Stores
in the State.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

28 MRSA § 451, first ¶, last sentence, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 268, § 2, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Notwithstanding the other provisions of this section, the commission, with the approval of the Commissioner of Finance and Administration, may reduce the price of liquor in 4 stores and establish at those 4 stores the price to which the 10% discount in section 204 shall be applicable. Retail prices shall be the same in all 4 stores and the prices to which the 10% discount in section 204 shall be applicable shall be the same in all 4 stores. One of these 4 stores shall be located in each of the following municipalities: Machias, Kittery, Presque Isle and Waterville.

FISCAL NOTE

At the present time, it is impossible to estimate whether passage of this bill will result in an increase or a loss of revenue to the State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill will permit the uniform reduction of retail prices and prices at which liquor is sold to licensees in 4 stores, to be located in Machias, Kittery, Presque Isle and Waterville.
