AN ACT Relating to Conferring Degrees by Beal Business School.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Degrees. In addition to the rights, privileges and powers granted to Beal Business School by the private and special laws of 1967, chapter 83, said school, by appropriate action of its trustees, may confer upon all who shall satisfactorily complete such courses of study as said trustees may prescribe, within the scope customarily established by colleges offering a 4-year curriculum, a baccalaureate degree in business science.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this bill to empower Beal Business School to issue a 4-year curriculum and baccalaureate degree in business science.
