COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 350, L.D. 1263, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Implement the Recommendations of the Trial Court  
Revision Commission."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 6th line of  
section 1 (5th line in L.D.) the underlined figure "6"  
and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '5'

Further amend said Bill in section 6 in that part  
designated "§19." by striking out in the 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th  
lines of the 2nd paragraph (2nd, 3rd and 4th lines of L.D.) the  
underlined words and punctuation "; provided, that there shall  
be a regional court center at a location within the County of  
Aroostook whether or not Aroostook be designated a separate  
region'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 12-A.

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to delete the requirement  
for a separate regional court center in Aroostook County and to  
delete section 12-A of the Bill being amended which deals  
with the procedure for appeals from the District Court which  
has been provided for in emergency legislation which has  
already been enacted by the 107th Legislature. The Bill also  
reduces the number of associate justices of the Supreme Judicial  
Court from 6 to 5.
