COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1006, L.D. 1274,
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Subdivision Law to Provide for
More Housing in the State."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in the 6th line (5th line
in L.D.) by striking out the underlined word "July" and
inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'January' and
by striking out everything after the date "1976"

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. 30 MRSA §4956, sub-§2, ¶C-1 is enacted
to read:

C-1. Upon receiving an application, the municipal
reviewing authority shall issue to the applicant
a dated receipt. Within 30 days from receipt of an
application, the municipal reviewing authority shall
notify the applicant in writing either that the
application is a complete application or, if the
application is incomplete, the specific additional
material needed to make a complete application. After
the municipal reviewing authority has determined
that a complete application has been filed, it
shall notify the applicant and begin its full
evaluation of the proposed subdivision.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of
sections 3, 4 and 5.

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides a notice date of completed applications for subdivision applicants.
