AN ACT Concerning the Approval of Repairs to Existing Septic Systems.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

22 MRSA § 42, sub-§ 3, 1st ¶, as last repealed and replaced by PL 1973, c. 521, § 1, is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

The rules and regulations adopted by the department shall provide with respect to the repair and replacement of existing septic systems that the local plumbing inspector may approve all such work and may issue all necessary permits without the approval of the department.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow the local plumbing inspector to approve repairs to existing septic systems without the necessity of returning to Augusta for authority to make necessary repairs.
