STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Car Purchases by Individuals Receiving General Assistance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

22 MRSA § 4504, 2nd ¶, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 788, § 94, is amended by adding after the first sentence a new sentence to read:

No person, or member of whose household, who owns a vehicle of model year less than 3 years prior to the most recent model year shall be eligible for relief.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will prohibit the owner of a car less than 3 years or any member of whose household who owns such a car from receiving general assistance payments.
