COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P.1020, L.D.1299,  
Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Furnishing of Updated  
Voting Lists by Registrars."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything  
after the amending clause and before the Statement  
of Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§176. Updated voting lists

Any person who has purchased a municipal voting  
list shall be entitled, for a period of up to one  
year after that purchase, to the following:

1. Updated list. A list of all additions,  
deletions and changes to the purchased list to be  
furnished automatically and periodically, if the  
municipality regularly and periodically updates its  
voting list. A municipal registrar shall begin  
furnishing lists requested under this subsection  
within 10 days after the request is made.

2. Current updated list. A list of all  
additions, deletions and changes to the purchased  
list which have occurred since the time of purchase  
to the time at which the request is made, or, if a  
previous request has been made under this  
subsection, from the time of the last request until  
the time of the current request. A municipal  
registrar shall furnish a list requested under this  
subsection within 10 days after a request is made  
under this subsection. A municipal registrar shall  
furnish lists under subsections 1 and 2 at no  
charge to the requestor.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will require voting list  
updates to be furnished at no cost to any person  
purchasing a voting list from a municipality.
