AN ACT Concerning the Furnishing of Updated Voting Lists by Registrars.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

21 MRSA § 176 is enacted to read:

§ 176. Updated voting lists

Upon request, a municipal registrar shall furnish to any person who has purchased a voting list from that municipality a copy of each new voting list issued by that municipality within one year of the date on which the original voting list was purchased. All new voting lists furnished to the original purchaser under this section shall be furnished at no cost to the original purchaser.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill will require voting list updates to be furnished at no cost to any person purchasing a voting list from a municipality.
