AN ACT to Amend Certain Eligibility Dates for the Pay Adjustment  
Granted to Certain State Employees and Officers.

---

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1.** P & SL 1973, c. 99, § 6, as last amended by P & SL 1973, c. 209, § 1, is amended to read:

**Sec. 6. Effective date.** The first adjustment of the salary plan shall be effective with the first pay period in July, 1973, and the second adjustment with the first pay period in ~~April~~ July, 1974.

**Sec. 2.** P & SL 1973, c. 209, § 3, is amended to read:

**Sec. 3. Retired state employees.** All members of the State Retirement System, notwithstanding the provisions of the Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1128 to the contrary, and eligible to retire on ~~April~~ **May 15, 1974**, who retire within 45 days of the effective date of this Act, shall be entitled to similar and equitable treatment, effective the first pay period in ~~April~~ **July** of 1974 or upon their retirement date whichever is later, in the form of retirees' cost-of-living adjustment originally scheduled to be put into effect July 1, 1974.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill changes certain eligibility dates under a private and special law passed in 1973 concerning a pay adjustment for certain active and retired state employees and officers who were made ineligible by a change in the eligibility dates which was enacted in the last special session.
