IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Concerning Municipal Property Tax Bills.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

36 MRSA § 507 is enacted to read:

§ 507. Taxes for county government

Municipalities shall indicate on every property tax bill the percentage of the tax allocated for county government use.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to make the cost of government more apparent to the taxpayer. There is a general lack of knowledge that the property tax supports 2 levels of government, and this bill will make that fact known to the public.
