**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Eugene W. Downer of Magalloway Plantation
for Automobile Damage Due to Highway Construction.**

Eugene W. Downer; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$392 to be paid to Eugene W. Downer of Magalloway Plantation for damage to his motor vehicle due to highway construction.

STATEMENT OF FACT

On and subsequent to October 27, 1972, a state highway crew had been working on the Otto Brook Bridge on Maine Route #16 at the foot of Deer Mountain and they caused a defect to remain in the highway after being notified of the defect. As a result, on October 31, 1972, as Mr. Downer drove over said defect his automobile was damaged in the amount of \$392. The accident was reported on the day it happened and the Department of Transportation retains a file on this accident. This is the same highway construction defect as involved in the resolves of 1973, chapter 31.
