## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 107TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1040, L.D. 1330, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Land Use Regulation Statutes."

Amend said Amendment by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §685-A, sub-§7, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 569, §10, is further amended by adding at the end the following blocked paragraph:

Permanent land use standards so adopted shall thereafter be in effect until 90 days after the date of adjournment of the next regular or special session of the Legislature, unless such next regular or special session shall adopt by legislative enactment such standards.'

Further amend said Amendment by renumbering section 3 to be section 4.

## Statement of Fact

This amendment will require legislative adoption of the permanent Land Use Regulation Commission standards.
