HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.  
1040, L.D. 1330, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Land Use Regulation  
Statutes."

Amend said Amendment by inserting after section 2 the  
following:

'Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §685-A, sub-§7, as last amended by  
PL 1973, c. 569, §10, is further amended by adding at the end  
the following blocked paragraph:  
Permanent land use standards so adopted shall be effective  
immediately, but shall be submitted to the next regular or  
special session of the Legislature for approval or modification.  
If the Legislature fails to act, such standards shall continue  
in full force and effect.'

Further amend said Amendment by renumbering section 3  
to be section 4.

Statement of Fact

This amendment will give the Legislature the opportunity  
to approve or modify the permanent Land Use Regulation Commission  
standards.
