HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.
1041, L.D. 1331, Bill, "AN ACT to Change the Participation
of Employees in the Classified Service in Political
Campaigns."

Amend said amendment by inserting at the end before
the statement of Fact the following:

'For the purpose of this section, a "conflict of
interest" shall mean a situation in which an employee's
participation in the affairs of a municipality results in
financial gain to him or members of his family other than
any regular compensation paid to him as an officer of that
municipality.'

Statement of Fact

This purpose of this amendment is to add to the committee
amendment provisions defining a conflict of interest which
were contained in Senate amendment A and to eliminate those
provisions concerning solicitation of funds.
