SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
H.P. 1041, L.D. 1331, Bill, "AN ACT to Change the Participation
of Employees in the Classified Service in Political Campaigns."

Amend said Amendment by inserting at the end before
the Statement of Fact the following:

'For the purpose of this section, a "conflict of interest"
shall mean a situation in which an employee's participation
in the affairs of a municipality results in financial gain to
him or members of his family other than any regular compensation
paid to him as an officer of that municipality.

Any officer or employee of the classified service of
this State may make contributions to a political party,
organization or candidate but shall not solicit any assessment,
subscription or contribution from any person for any partisan
political purpose.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the meaning
of "conflict of interest."
