HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1055,
L.D. 1332, Bill, "AN ACT Increasing the State Gasoline Tax."

Amend said amendment by striking out all of the 13th line
of section 10 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'V. Highway and bridge improvement	2,319,000	2,564,000
VI. Traffic Service	50,000	50,000

Any municipality which has expended funds for traffic
service in the year 1975 and prior to the effective date of this
Act shall be reimbursed such amount provided the amount claimed
by the municipality does not exceed the Transportation Department's
estimate for 1975.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow the Department
of Transportation to continue pavement markings on routed highways
in urban areas as in the past where communities have requested
the department to provide this service.
