Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the 13th
line of section 10 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'V. Highway and bridge improvement	2,189,000	2,434,000
VI. Traffic Services	50,000	50,000
VII. Bikeways and Bike Paths	130,000	130,000'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allocate \$130,000
each year of the biennium for construction of bikeways and
to continue pavement markings on routed highways in urban areas
as in the past where communities have requested the department
to provide this service.
